**RESOLUTION: KIC-05-XX**

**TITLE: A RESOLUTION OF THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE KETCHIKAN INDIAN COMMUNITY AFFIRMING ITS SUPPORT OF THE NAHA BAY PRESERVATION COALITION PROJECT AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the Tribal Council of the Ketchikan Indian Community, doing business as the Ketchikan Indian Community (“KIC” or the “Tribe”), is a federally recognized Tribal government organized under a Constitution and Bylaws (collectively, the “Constitution”) ratified on January 27, 1940, pursuant to Section 16 of the Indian Reorganization Act (IRA) of 1936 as amended; and

**WHEREAS,** the KIC Tribal Council (the “Tribal Council”) is the representative Tribal Government of the Tribe; and

**WHEREAS,** the KIC Tribal Council is empowered under Article V, Section 1(m) of the KIC Constitution to “protect the general welfare and security” of the KIC Tribal Government; and

**WHEREAS,** The Naha Bay area is being threatened with potentially harmful development by the sale to and from Sealaska Corporation, and

**WHEREAS,** KIC members and their families have lived and subsisted for many years in this general area, and

**WHEREAS,** there has been a recent effort by a group known as the Naha Bay Preservation Coalition to keep the area in pristine and natural “Public Park” condition, and

**WHEREAS,** KIC members would be involved in the planning of this public use, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE ABOVE FACTS, IT IS RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE KETCHIKAN INDIAN COMMUNITY as follows:**

Section 1. The KIC tribal council does hereby authorize and support the Naha Bay Preservation Coalition and the effort to secure land from the Sealaska Corporation for a compatible “Public Park” use.

Section 2. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
